

**Additions and corrections**

P. 76, right column, line 6 from below: Koehler & Vaney, 1905 . . . . . *Read* Vaney, 1908.

P. 127, left column, line 3 from below: ThCel, 1879 . . . . . *Read* ThCel, 1882.

P. 235, left column. With regard to the penetration of species into the Mediterranean deep sea the following information from E. Tortonese 1965 (Fauna d'Italia, 6) should be noted: (1) *Mesothuria verrilli* may not occur in the Mediterranean, the recorded specimens probably belonging to *M. intestinalis*. (2) *Molfiadia musculus* penetrates to at least 820 m. (3) The molpadonian *Hedingia mediterranea* is known from the type specimen only (Tyrrhenian Sea: 800-1005 m). The species is likely to be identical with *H. albicans* (North Atlantic, Bay of Bengal, southwestern Pacific: 491-3200 m).
